



SUMMER GARDEN CHECKLIST

- Weed the base of fruit trees
- Prune off old or dried leaves from plants
- Ensure gardens are mulched and the soil is covered
- Add temporary shade if plants are struggling
- Purchase any extra seedlings if sowed seeds didn't work out
- Harvest summer produce to promote more production
- Plant flowers to encourage pollinators
- Tie and secure Tomatoes and other climbers weekly
- Check Pumpkin and Squash and manually pollinate if necessary
- Check sprinkler systems are clean and working
- Hand water in the evening or early morning to reduce evaporation
- Cut off any flower heads to promote growth and save dried seeds
- Leave water out for wildlife such as Birds, Bees and Lizards
- Keep on top of weeds, especially removing grasses before they go to seed
- Take extra care of potted plants as they heat up fast in summer
