



AUTUMN GARDEN CHECKLIST

- Weed the base of fruit trees and pull back the mulch to prevent rot
- Harvest all leftover summer produce
- Add fresh compost to the garden beds
- Ensure the soil is covered with fresh mulch
- Plant cool-weather seeds
- Remove dead or finished summer plants and compost
- Harvest and store your Pumpkins and Sweet Potatoes
- Reduce water schedules to accommodate rain and reduced temperatures
- Tidy and put away un-used stakes and trellis
- Plant winter bulbs
- Take cuttings and plant for future reproduction
- Save the seeds from summer crops
- Preserve excess food
- Rake up dried leaves for compost or mulch
- Prune and cut back fruit trees that have finished fruiting (mulberry, feijoa)
