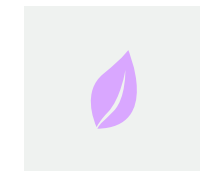

Attract beneficial insects



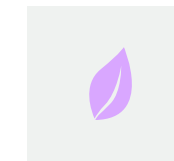
Reduces nutrition depletion

Less diseases



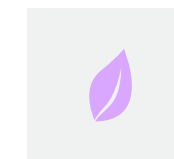
Promotes soil health

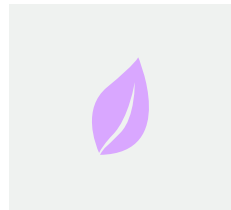

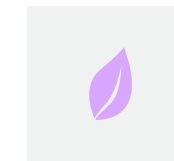

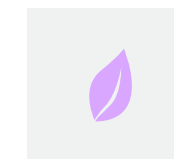
